

COVID-19 Vaccine Research Study: Focus Group

The Johns Hopkins COVID-19 Vaccine Risk Uptake study is recruiting **in-home healthcare providers** to participate in focus groups to discuss motivation, hesitancy, and situational factors that impact awareness, acceptability, and access to vaccines.

What you would do

The focus groups address ongoing communication efforts about COVID-19 vaccination, and how your community's values, culture and ethics inform your interpretation of these messages.

Groups are conducted remotely (over Zoom) and last approximately 90 minutes.

Why it matters

Results will be used to develop best practices for public health officials on meeting home healthcare workers' needs around vaccination and, with your participation and thoughtful input, we hope to help improve the public's participation in the COVID-19 vaccination effort.
